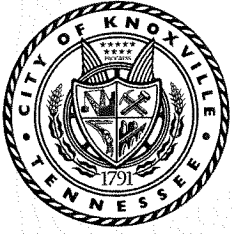

RE: Beer Permit for Neyland Stadium - Aramark Bowl, 1300 Phillip Fulmer Way Knoxville, TN 37916

Dear Beer Permit Holder:

On September 24, 2022, your business was the subject of a sting, conducted by the Knoxville Police Department, for underage beer sales. During this operation, an employee of your business was issued a citation for violation of Knoxville City Code section 4-34, **Sale to Underage Persons**. This is the **second** citation for underage sale that your business has received within a two-year period.

City of Knoxville Ordinance O-215-2013 (enclosed) provides that after the second underage sales violation occurring within two years of the first violation, the permit holder "shall appear before the beer board at an administrative hearing. No less than five (5) business days prior to the scheduled administrative hearing, the permit holder shall pay a fine and file a revised written remedial plan with the City Recorder." **The fine is \$500.** If either the revised remedial plan or fine has not been submitted to the City Recorder's office at least five (5) business days prior to the administrative hearing, the City Law Department will file a noncompliance complaint against the permit holder, and a suspension/revocation hearing will be conducted. The permit holder should understand, however, that an administrative hearing may result in an immediate referral by the Beer Board to a suspension/revocation hearing.

An administrative hearing has been scheduled for your business to appear before the Knoxville City Beer Board on **Tuesday, October 18, 2022 at 5:00pm** in the **Main Assembly Room of the City-County Building, 400 Main Street**. You may wish to be represented by legal counsel at this hearing, but are not required to do so. The fine must be paid and the remedial plan submitted to the City Recorder's Office, Room 467 City-County Building, 400 Main Street, at least **five (5) business days prior** to the hearing. **Please pay by certified check or cash.
