Six "PLEAS" for Protection Against Recreational Water Illnesses (RWIs)

PLEASE do not use the splashpad when you have diarrhea. This is especially important for kids in diapers.

PLEASE do not swallow water.

PLEASE practice good hygiene. Wash your hands after using the toilet or changing diapers.

PLEASE take you kids on bathroom breaks or check diapers often.

PLEASE change diapers in a bathroom and not at or near the splashpad.

PLEASE wash your child (especially the rear end)
thoroughly with soap and water before using the splashpad.
